The first time I had asked Fabrizio to varnish, he had over 160 mts of cap rails to work on, he was able to lay three coats on in two weeks this was including stripping approximately 40 meters and building up 8 coats, Also I had asked his team to remove the rubber in between the butt joints so we could build up the varnish in the joints.

Fabrizio and his team were able to complete the work to a very high standard Fabrizio is very meticulous about the finish and will not leave the job to it is to his satisfaction.

One thing the crew and I noticed was how clean they kept the boat, everyday Fabrizio would get his team to go around and make sure the decks were clean of rubbish and dust also making sure all areas were protected properly before starting.

Another advantage is Fabrizio is a professional carpenter, The Benedetti family have a large workshop in Porto Santo Stefano, Tuscany, Italy where they can produce high quality items and ship worldwide.
